****NOTICE****

South Queen Street & Ramp Closure

Beginning the week of December 15, 2014, weather depending, S. Queen Street will be closed to incoming and outgoing traffic for approximately six months. Access to homes will NOT be affected. Traffic on the ramp to I-395 S will also be shifted slightly to the left to allow for the construction of the ultimate ramp and the final section of the box culvert.

On the same day that S. Queen Street is closed and traffic on the ramp to I-395 South is shifted, traffic on Columbia Pike to I-395 North will also follow a new pattern. All traffic from Columbia Pike eastbound to I-395 North or South must stay in the right lane. The right lane will exit on the ramp to 395 North and South. **There will no longer be a left turn from Route 244 EB at the S. Quinn signal to 395.** The left lane of Columbia Pike eastbound will continue eastbound towards the Pentagon. All traffic on Columbia Pike westbound heading towards I-395 North or South must make effectively a “U-turn” at the S. Queen Street intersection onto the ramp.

All local traffic will be rerouted per the exhibit below.
