
COLUMBIA PIKE MULTIMODAL PROJECT; SEGMENT F:

Organizers estimate around 500 people were in attendance. The event raised \$856.38 for the Randolph Elementary School PTA Food Pantry (at the time of printing)! Additionally, over 1,000 pounds food was donated to Arlington Food Assistance Center (AFAC) as a part of the event, which is almost 200 pounds more than last year!
