County Asks for DP Help in Preparing to Bury Utilities on Pike

In order for Arlington County to move forward with the second and final phase of utility undergrounding along Columbia Pike (from Garfield to Oakland Street), several agreements with property owners need to be concluded. These are referred to as "easements." They allow the use of the property during construction or grant a permanent right of access. Douglas Park Civic Association agreed to help contact owners to help move the project forward.

If your name is on p. 3, please contact the designated staff person. If you're in contact with anyone on this, please emphasize to them the importance of the utility undergrounding project. It will make our end of Columbia Pike look as attractive as the area between Walter Reed Drive and Courthouse Road, and it will improve the value of all the affected properties. Milestone Construction Awarded \$6.5 Million Park Project

Milestone Construction Services Inc., an Inc 500 company, has been awarded the first phase of a massive redevelopment of Barcroft Park in Arlington County, VA. The improvements will provide new and improved recreational amenities to neighbors and county residents at one of the largest and most heavily used parks in the county.

The improvements will include the construction of two new lighted ball fields, two new lighted soccer fields, batting cages, handball wall, a three-level parking garage and space for community festivals and cultural events. Arlington Co. hopes to attract all-state sporting tournaments to Barcroft Park. Construction on Barcroft Park commenced in late fall 2003 and will be completed by fall 2004.

Plans for Walter Reed Center's Renovation on Hold

Arlington Co. Parks and Rec. staff gave an update on the Walter Reed Community Center's lack of progress at a meeting of the Columbia Heights Civic Assn. on Nov. 17. Hayward Corley from the county parks and recreation dept. gave the presentation. The construction bidding period closed and the bids came in about \$1M higher than the \$4.5–5M budgeted in the bond issue two years ago. The county wants to find the additional money within the budget. No timetable has been established and they are not considering reducing the scope of the project. *—Chris Durel, cmdurel@aol.com*
