EXPANSION OF ART 45 BUS SERVICE

Arlington Transit's (ART) 45 line will undergo some major expansions in service from Sunday 13 December. This line connects the west side of Douglas Park and the Pike Corridor to Courthouse and Rosslyn metro stations. Key changes include:

- Addition of Saturday and Sunday service
- More frequent service during rush hours
- More frequent night service

We **stage** the house and **advise** and **coordinate** the repairs. We **measure** all rooms and insert them into the **MRIS** and other **databases** for **agents** and **buyers**.
